Nursery is open for all services. Children's church is available in the Children's area.



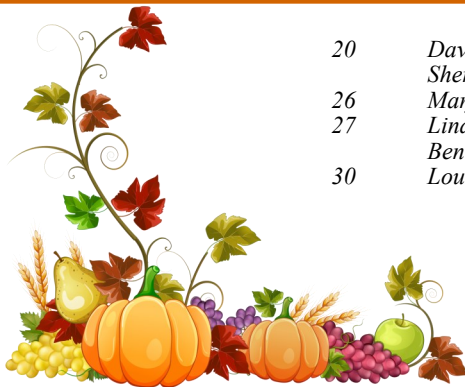
What's for dinner?????

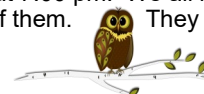
