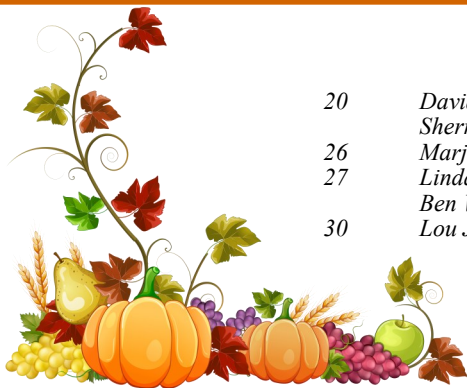


RECYCLE...REUSE
