IMPORTANT...Orders and Expenditures

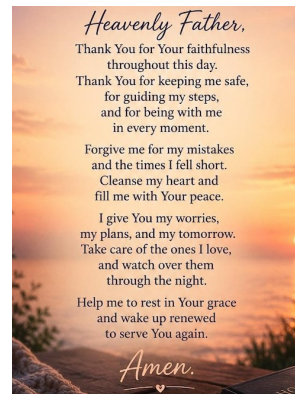
